This discography provides a complete numerical catalogue of Italian gramophone recordings made by the Gramophone Company Ltd. Kelly has effectively used the archives and registers of EMI Limited (The Gramophone Company) to offer a richly detailed picture of recording activity during the years 1898 to 1929. The main catalog is divided into three sections: recordings issued on the Gramophone label; recordings issued on the Zonophone label, including the Trento-Trieste Supplement; and recordings issued on the Gramophone Green label. Kelly's introduction gives an overview of the company's history and cataloging practices. He not only examines the history of the Italian Gramophone Company, but adds the discographical record of the Victor Talking Machine Company, of which Gramophone was the European, Asian, and African partner.

Schablonen wie ›österreichischer Palestrina‹, ›trockener Kontrapunktiker‹ und ›Lehrmeister im strengen Satz‹ haben das Profil des kaiserlichen Hofkapellmeisters Johann Joseph Fux (? 1660–1741) für die Nachwelt geprägt. Die Langlebigkeit seiner musiktheoretischen Schrift Gradus ad Parnassum, in Teilen auch des musikpädagogisch motivierten Singfundament unterstützen, ja trugen dieses Bild. Demgegenüber weist aber sein musikalisches Schaffen eine ungeahnte Reichhaltigkeit auf – es umfasst keineswegs nur polyphon gesetzte, auch nicht durchwegs kirchenmusikalische Werke, sondern zeigt mit Instrumentalkompositionen und dramatischen Werken, dass Fux Kompositionen für alle spätbarocken Stilwelten der Musik für Kirche, Kammer und Theater im süddeutsch-österreichischen Raum beigesteuert hat. Erstmals seit Ludwig Ritter von Köchel, der 1872 ein "Thematisches Verzeichniss der Compositionen von Johann Josef Fux" publiziert hat, wird das Œuvre des kaiserlichen Hofka-pellmeisters nun wieder in seiner Gesamtheit erschlossen. Für das vorliegende Verzeichnis wurde dazu eine spezifische, aber auch philologisch tragfähige Lösung zum adäquaten Umgang mit Autorschaft, Beschaffenheit der Überlieferung und bezüglich der Anordnungsprinzipien erarbeitet. Im ersten Band des Fux-Werke-Verzeichnisses sind Gradus ad Parnassum und Singfundament, die geistlichen und weltlichen dramatischen Werke sowie die Instrumentalwerke des Komponisten nachgewiesen.

This volume contains the written versions of the lectures delivered by the participants of the Colloquium Origenianum Nonum held in Pecs (Hungary, 29 August - 2 September 2005). The main topic of the conference was Origen and the religious practice of his time. Here 49 scholars from some 18 countries publish their newest findings on the greatest and most influential Christian thinker before Augustine, who laid the foundation of the Biblical textual studies, created systematic theology, and was regarded as an authentic spiritual leader of Christianity. The papers not only provide the best overview on a lively field of studies but also demonstrate how Origen's heritage in Christian history, theology and spirituality carried with it the imprint of one of the most vital traditions of our civilization. Similarly to the volumes of the earlier conferences (Boston 1989, Chantilly 1993, Hofgeismar-Marburg 1997 and Pisa 2001), the contributions are published by the series Bibliotheca Ephemeridum Theologicarum Lovaniensium.

The 70th volume of the Eranos Yearbooks presents the work of the last three years of activities at the Eranos Foundation (2009–2011). From 1933 onwards, the Eranos Conferences took shape in Ascona-Moscia (Switzerland), springing from the idea of Olga Fröbe-Kapteyn to create a 'Meeting Place of East and West'.

Under the influence of the psychologist Carl Gustav Jung and other prominent leaders of that era, the Eranos Conferences found their way towards symbolical, archetypal, and mythological motifs. The Eranos gathering is symbolized by its famous Round Table, the image and meaning of which inspired many of the leading thinkers of the 20th century. For more than 70 years, depth psychologists, philosophers, theologians, orientalists, historians of religions as well as natural scientists find at Eranos a unique place where they could meet and exchange views. The rich collection of Eranos Yearbooks bears testimony to an immense and original work accomplished in various fields of learning.
